

Canadian Collaborative Procurement Initiative (CCPI)

The Canadian Collaborative Procurement Initiative (CCPI) is a federal/provincial-territorial (FPT) procurement initiative in which the Government of Newfoundland & Labrador is participating. Through the CCPI, NL public bodies are able to use Government of Canada procurement instruments (e.g., standing offers and supply arrangements) and comply with requirements under the Province's Procurement Framework.

Commodities Available

Dozens of commodities are currently available for purchase through PSPC procurement instruments. Participating in CCPI

- All Newfoundland & Labrador-based participants in the CCPI are granted access to PSPC's secure web portal (called SOSA) where CCPI procurement instruments, including pricing, can be viewed (<https://buyandsell.gc.ca/applications/standing-offers-and-supply-arrangements-application-SOSA-App>).
- Once your department or organization has indicated it wishes to access CCPI procurement instruments by advising the Government of Newfoundland & Labrador, a SOSA account manager from PSPC will contact you to setup a [Buyandsell.gc.ca](https://buyandsell.gc.ca) account from which you will be able to access the secure SOSA application.
